

FLAG DAY STAR MAZE

On June 14 in 1893 Philadelphia observed the first Flag Day. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a presidential proclamation establishing a national Flag Day to be held on June 14. Congress, in 1949, designated June 14 of each year as "Flag Day" and asked that the President issue an annual proclamation calling for its observance and for the display of the U.S. flag on all Federal Government buildings.
